<b>AFFORDABLE CARE ACT</b> Support Affordable Care Act (ACA), including Medicaid expansion?	Yes. <a href="#">Build on ACA</a> . As state senator, <a href="#">sponsored legislation to expand Medicaid eligibility</a> . <a href="#">“I have been always about expanding Kansans’ access to health care.”</a> Leading push to <a href="#">end surprise medical bills</a> .	No. Opposed Medicaid expansion, saying it would <a href="#">bankrupt health care system while failing to provide “meaningful health care for the most vulnerable.”</a> Voted to <a href="#">“repeal and replace” Obamacare</a> . <a href="#">“Morally, spiritually, socially,”</a> some <a href="#">“just don’t want health care.”</a>
<b>CAMPAIGN FINANCE</b> Make political ads disclose their largest funders?	Yes. <a href="#">“Elections should be decided by candidates campaigning out in the open, not by mysterious special-interest groups.”</a>	No position found. <a href="#">Voted against SHIELD Act, which would make campaigns report election interference from foreign powers.</a>
<b>CLIMATE CHANGE</b> Consider human-caused climate change a serious threat?	Yes. <a href="#">“Climate change and extreme weather are some of the most significant challenges facing Kansas’ farmers and ranchers.”</a> ... <a href="#">“Without action, ... our grandchildren will come of age in an unrecognizable world.”</a>	No. <a href="#">“I’m not sure ... there is ... even climate change. ... It’s something that we should continue to study and make sure our ecology continues to improve.”</a>
<b>CLIMATE CHANGE</b> Address as a top priority by taxing or limiting output of greenhouse gases?	Yes. <a href="#">Supports “a comprehensive plan to reduce carbon emissions.”</a> Opposed efforts to repeal state renewable energy standard. <a href="#">Would harness state’s wind energy potential.</a>	No. <a href="#">Voted for a resolution opposing a carbon tax. “Innovating our way to solutions has been a trademark of the American spirit since our country’s inception.”</a>
<b>COURTS — SUPREME COURT</b> Support picking Ginsburg replacement now or letting November winner select?	No. Avoid rushing replacement. <a href="#">“Now is not the time to politicize the Supreme Court.”</a> See <a href="#">CEEP Supreme Court guide</a> .	Yes. Calls <a href="#">for quick action</a> . See <a href="#">CEEP Supreme Court guide</a> .
<b>COVID-19</b> Support administration’s response to coronavirus pandemic?	No. <a href="#">Opposes</a> statewide mask mandate, but says Marshall’s unmasked campaign events show more concern <a href="#">“with his political health than” Kansans’ health</a> . <a href="#">“Potentially dangerous ... to promote unproven medicine”</a> like hydroxychloroquine as a cure.	Yes. Trump is <a href="#">standing up “for our rights.”</a> More would have died <a href="#">from shutting down the economy than the virus itself</a> . <a href="#">“We are winning the war against this invisible enemy.”</a> Says he is taking <a href="#">hydroxychloroquine for prevention</a> .
<b>EDUCATION</b> Use public funding for private and/or for-profit schools?	No. <a href="#">“Private schools have no requirements for accountability” and are not required to take all students, unlike public institutions.</a>	No position found.
<b>ENVIRONMENT</b> Tighten or loosen environmental regulations?	Tighten. <a href="#">“We must reduce carbon emissions,”</a> but <a href="#">doesn’t support</a> Green New Deal. <a href="#">League of Conservation Voters endorsed.</a>	Loosen. <a href="#">“Agriculture is the lifeblood of Kansas, and we Kansans know our land better than federal bureaucrats.”</a>
<b>FINANCIAL REGULATION</b> Tighten or loosen bank regulation?	No position found.	Loosen. <a href="#">“Overregulation of community banks limits consumer access to credit.”</a>

<b>GUN RULES</b> Enact more restrictive legislation on guns?	Yes. <a href="#">“Like almost everyone, including the majority of NRA members, I support universal background checks and reasonable gun safety training standards.”</a>	No. <a href="#">“I believe all Americans have a right to keep and bear arms and I refuse to support legislation that would strip that right away from law-abiding citizens.”</a>
<b>IMMIGRATION</b> Support path to citizenship for undocumented residents, including those brought to the U.S. as children? Position on expanding border wall?	Yes. <a href="#">“Immigrants play a critical role in Kansas’ economy.”</a> Need <a href="#">“pathway to citizenship for those ... who have stayed out of trouble and... are contributing to our society.”</a> Supports <a href="#">strong border security</a> ; unclear on wall.	No. <a href="#">Opposed path to citizenship for DACA participants.</a> <a href="#">“Build a wall.”</a> <a href="#">“Turn off magnets that attract, promote, encourage and allow migrants to enter our country under false pretenses.”</a>
<b>IRAN</b> Require congressional approval for military attacks on Iran?	No position found.	No. <a href="#">Voted against requiring Congressional approval.</a>
<b>LABOR</b> Support “right to work” laws, barring unions from mandating dues?	No position found, but <a href="#">historically supportive</a> of union positions.	Yes. <a href="#">Co-sponsored</a> 2019-2020 National Right-to-Work Act.
<b>LEGAL ABORTION</b> Ban or keep legal?	Legal. <a href="#">Voted against requiring telling patients that abortions using a pill can be reversed.</a> When <a href="#">“making complex medical decisions,”</a> <a href="#">no one wants “a politician in the middle.”</a>	Ban. <a href="#">Overturn Roe v. Wade. No exceptions for rape or incest. Could never “in my heart, find any reason to end a life.”</a>
<b>LGBT RIGHTS</b> Support same-sex marriage and other LGBT rights issues?	Yes. <a href="#">“I support the people of Kansas. I do not condemn whoever they are.”</a>	No. Supported <a href="#">ban on transgender people serving in the military because Trump said that his generals supported the ban.</a>
<b>MARIJUANA</b> Keep illegal or decriminalize?	Decriminalize. <a href="#">Supports decriminalization of marijuana.</a>	Keep illegal. Willing to consider medical use, but <a href="#">“not convinced ... it’s medically proven.”</a>
<b>MINIMUM WAGE</b> Raise federal hourly minimum wage above current \$7.25?	Yes. <a href="#">“I support raising the minimum wage to a living wage.”</a>	No. <a href="#">“Raising the minimum wage has a proven record of killing jobs,”</a> particularly <a href="#">“those held by lower-income individuals.”</a>
<b>PLANNED PARENTHOOD</b> Allow Planned Parenthood’s receiving public funds for non-abortion care?	Yes. <a href="#">Has been endorsed by Planned Parenthood.</a>	No. <a href="#">“Federal funds should never go to abortion providers.”</a>
<b>POLICE/COMMUNITY</b> Restrict police use of force and increase public oversight?	Yes. Supports the Justice in Policing Act. Against defunding police, but supports reforms to <a href="#">“help end inequities in our systems that harm communities of color.”</a>	No. <a href="#">“I’m going to do everything I can to make sure that the police have everything that they need to protect property and life.”</a>
<b>SAUDI ARABIA</b> Block arms sales to Saudi Arabia?	No position found.	No. <a href="#">Voted against blocking arms sales to Saudi Arabia.</a>
<b>STUDENT FINANCIAL AID</b> Support free or subsidized tuition or loan subsidies for lower-income individuals?	No. <a href="#">Doesn’t support free college, but more financial support for students and let students refinance loans.</a>	Unclear. <a href="#">Supported public service loan forgiveness program.</a>
<b>TAXES</b> Support administration’s \$1.9 trillion (2017) tax cuts?	No. <a href="#">Tax cuts ballooned the deficit and benefited wealthy over middle class Kansans.</a> <a href="#">Opposed</a> similar Kansas tax cuts.	Yes. <a href="#">Voted in favor of the tax cuts.</a> Average Kansas family kept <a href="#">“\$2,000 of their hard-earned money.”</a>
<b>VOTING RIGHTS</b> Support stricter ID requirements and other rules on voting?	No. Make it easier to vote, including <a href="#">early voting, same-day registration for eligible voters, and postage-paid return envelopes for mail-in ballots.</a>	Yes. Opposed HR1, <a href="#">which included various measures to make voting easier. Opponents said this risked voter fraud and gave government undue power to interfere.</a>
