Renewable Energy: Support government subsidies for renewable energy?	Unknown.	Yes. <u>Supports alternative energy</u> <u>subsidies, but also recognizes Missouri's</u> <u>dependence on coal and supported</u> <u>Keystone Pipeline</u> .
<b>Student Debt and Financial Aid:</b> Refinance student loans at lower rates, by raising high- earner taxes? Increase student financial aid, like Pell Grants?	Unclear, but says <u>universities waste</u> <u>billions of public funds and leave</u> <u>families with billions of debt, giving</u> <u>students "worthless degrees" and</u> <u>indoctrinating them in far-left thinking</u> .	Yes. Co-sponsored Elizabeth Warren proposal to refinance student loans. Supports increasing Pell Grants.
Taxes: Support <u>President Trump's tax cuts</u> ? Voting Rights: Support stricter voting rules like voter ID requirements or reduced registration times, even if they prevent some people from voting?
